- The Festival is from 10 am to 2 pm. Please arrive by 9:00am to set up and be ready to sell by 10 am.
- Vendors are expected to stay until the close of the event.
- All Food Vendors are asked to donate 10% of their total sales to the Alexandria Museum of Art Education Department.
