All K-12 students in Rapides Parish are eligible to enter the competition. Approximately 40 works will be selected to participate in the competition and to be on display at the Alexandria Museum of Art. Not all entered works are accepted but all are judged without distinguishing information other than grade level.

Deadline to Enter: Monday, January 31, 2022, midnight

HOW TO ENTER:

Go to www.themuseum.org/youthart and complete Entry Form. Incomplete forms will not be accepted. Works may be submitted by teachers, parents or high school students on their own behalf. Notifications of accepted entries will be made by email on entry form on February 9, 2022.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- One entry per student. Work must be completed by student only.
- All works must be created during the current 2021-2022 school year.
- Individual and original artwork only. No reproductions of licensed work or group projects will be accepted. Computer generated artwork is not eligible.
- Total dimensions of 2-D artwork should not exceed 25"x31".
- Works on stretched canvas must have painted edges but do not require matting.
- 3-D pieces are limited to 3' in all measurements and must be less than 20lbs.
- No changes or substitutions are allowed after submission.

TIP: Pre-cut mats are available at local arts and craft stores in a variety of sizes. Matting service for virtual and homeschool students (those without an art teacher) is available.

JUDGE'S CONSIDERATIONS:

Judge critiques works based on creativity, originality, execution and overall quality of presentation. Not all entered works are accepted. All works are juried and judged without distinguishing information other than grade level.

AWARDS:

Blick Art Materials Gift Cards, AMoA Memberships and Loot Bags
1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place Awards will be presented in K-2, 3-5, 6-8 and 9-12 grade level categories and Viewer's Choice Award.
