



## **Educator's Vault Lesson**

**Artist: Ida Kohlmeyer**  
**Grade Level: Secondary**

### **Inspiration:**

Allow students to observe the image of *Holy Man 96-1* from AMoA's Educators Vault.

### **Questions for Students:**

- What shapes can you find?
- What makes the figure a man?
- How would you classify this sculpture? Realistic, abstract or non-objective?

### **Process:**

1. Assign students to create their own holy man, or holy woman.
2. Have students draw the sculpture in their sketchbooks or on a piece of drawing paper. Remind them that they are drawing a form and should show sides and frontal views. It is to be an abstract made of geometric and organic shape.
3. Have students soften any angles by rounding the edges.
4. Students will use construction paper to create the image.
5. Encourage students to add layers of construction paper for more interest. Students will use paint pens or markers to add details.
