JULY 10-28, 2023: Summer Art Camps at AMoA

3 Weeks, Mondays – Fridays 8:30am – 4:15pm

Summer Camp at AMoA is all ART, all day.

Each week will offer different instructors, technique and mediums.

All applications must be received at AMoA by **April 30, 2023.**

So, you wanna be a summer camp counselor...

When applying to be a summer camp counselor with AMoA, please consider the following:

- Applicants must be at least 16 years old and be in good behavioral standing at their school.
- Applicants 18 years of age or older may be required to undergo a background check.
- AMoA will select those best qualified for each camp. Good character, positivity, compassion and critical thinking skills are a must have for all applicants. If you do not possess these traits, please do not apply.
- Consistent attendance is extremely important. Applicants are required to work every day the program is open. If you know you are unable to attend all days, please do not apply.
- Accepted applicants will be notified by email and will be asked to participate in orientation.
- All Counselors are REQUIRED TO ATTEND Camp Orientation Sessions at AMoA and will be required to complete additional paperwork. Minors will require guardian/parent signatures.
- Counselors shall be compensated for service with Service Hours (1hr=1hr) or with a stipend of \$150 per week of service, as indicated on application.
- All counselors must complete an Application Form, Medical Form, W-9 form (if applicable), and sign a contract of service as required by LSUA.
- Counselors will be responsible for their own transportation to and from the location of camp.
- Counselors receiving compensation with service hours are to provide necessary service logs.
